

# TravelTracker Modules

TravelTracker is an integrated travel tracking service. It complements your Membership by delivering pre-departure travel information, quickly finding and communicating with travellers, as well as delivering essential management reports to keep senior managers informed.



## Added Value

Are you sure of the precise locations of your travellers and expatriates? In the event of an emergency will you have their latest contact details and know how their location relates to the assets in their vicinity?

Increase your confidence and reduce risks by enhancing TravelTracker with the following options.

## SMS Communications

Somewhere in the world something has happened. You know your travellers and expatriates have the best analysis available, through International SOS's alerts, but how do you confirm they are okay?

Use two-way SMS (texting) to get travellers to confirm their status by broadcasting a text message from TravelTracker to everyone in an affected area. It will automatically log travellers' replies allowing you to react accordingly.

## Tracking Your Location

Whilst itinerary data provide details of your travellers' intended trips, those choosing to *check-in*, using the Assistance App Check-In, can confirm where they actually are.

TravelTracker users can see where and when travellers have checked-in; from specific searches or the map. This adds tangible confidence to itinerary data.

For high-risk journeys you can add background tracking. This upgrade is available with Active Monitoring.

## Locating Expatriates

TravelTracker provides the ability to add the locations of international assignees. These locations may then be viewed or identified using explicit search criteria. Locations are shown down to street level, so as to quickly view the potential impact of events.

## Identifying Buildings

With the building module enabled, you can input hundreds of buildings, sites or locations into TravelTracker. This complements information on International SOS Clinics, Assistance Centres and embassies. By viewing your buildings on the same map as travellers and expatriates, you will be able to assess your full exposure of how incidents could impact your business.
