INTERNATIONAL SOS IN SENEGAL

THE HEALTH LANDSCAPE

As one of the most stable countries in Africa, Senegal has seen the development of new industries over the past few years. Consequently, the latest surge in oil and gas activities in the country has led to a significant increase in the number of foreign assignees and increased expectations from national employees alike. While the country has an acceptable standard of healthcare delivery in larger cities, local healthcare providers may lack experience in terms of the oil and gas industry's stringent Health and Safety requirements.

In times of pandemic, international companies may find it challenging to navigate the local healthcare system and to access potentially saturated Emergency and Intensive Care Units (ICU). As an indicator, Senegal boasts about 1% of the number of ICU beds that a similar sized European population would have access to.

THE SECURITY LANDSCAPE

The security environment in Senegal remains overall relatively benign, with petty theft being the primary risk faced by in-country workforce in the main business and tourist areas, although residential break-ins are also common. However, protests over economic or social grievances can occasionally turn violent, and political unrest can also occur around election time. The planned 2022 legislative elections and 2023 presidential elections are two such periods where it is important to have sound escalation and crisis management planning as well as access to security information and assistance in order to protect your domestic workforce or assignees.

Banditry is also a concern in southern Casamance, where separatist rebels operate, and in areas close to the border with Mali, where there are increasing concerns over cross-border movements by Islamist extremist and smuggler groups from Mali. Travelling in such areas therefore require greater planning and vigilance.


