This shared medical facility provides expatriate physicians who are general practitioners with interest in emergency intensive care and infectious diseases. In addition, we provide national doctors with international medical experience specialising in emergency care and general medical services. Doctors are available with English and French language skills and are accustomed to working in a multinational and multicultural community.

The training and credentials of our International SOS medical team meet stringent international standards for medical professionals.



# HEALTHCARE FOR EMPLOYEES THE INTERNATIONAL SOS MAURITANIA SHARED MEDICAL FACILITY

Healthcare is a top priority whenever employees are sent overseas. Many companies are finding that although international markets are developing rapidly and new markets continue to emerge, many of these markets lack the adequate standards of healthcare in the cities they deploy their people to.

Away from heavily populated international style cities, it can be challenging to find English-speaking medical professionals who can provide international standards of care.

In order to meet the needs of our clients in Mauritania, together with the support of the International Oil Companies (IOC) operating in Mauritania, International SOS has established a shared clinic providing international standards of care to their subscribers. It is staffed with expatriate and local doctors trained in Advanced Cardiac Life Support and Advanced Trauma Life Support, to ensure that clinic subscribers receive the levels of care which they are accustomed to.



### **MEDICAL FACILITY CAPABILITIES**

The medical facility provides primary and emergency medical care and occupational health services. Emergency services are available 24/7 and supported by a fully equipped emergency room and an advanced life support ground ambulance with medical escort.

There is a proven and effective emergency evacuation system which involves all aspects of clearance, transport and medical escort, including arrangements with charter companies to operate fixed-wing and helicopter evacuations.

Access to the services provided at the medical facility are restricted only to individuals who are declared as eligible members by subscribing companies of the medical facility plan.


